Expectations of the Entire Board

The board is responsible for:

1. Ensuring strong fiduciary oversight and financial management
2. Determining the mission and purpose of the organization
3. Selecting and evaluating the performance of the Executive Director
4. Planning all strategic and organizational functions
5. Fundraising and resource development
6. Approving and monitoring NH Hunger Solutions programs and services
7. Enhancing NH Hunger Solutions public image
8. Assessing its own performance as the governing body of NH Hunger Solutions
4. Leverage connections, networks, and resources for collective action to achieve organization's mission
5. Give a meaningful personal financial donation
6. Help identify connections that can benefit the organization's fundraising and reputational standing that influence public policy
7. Conscientiously attend and participate in board meetings
8. Participate fully in one or more committee

Board Members are also expected to:

1. Follow the organization's bylaws, policies and board resolutions
2. Sign an annual conflict of interest disclosure and update as necessary and disclose potential conflicts before meetings and before conflicts occur
3. Maintain confidentiality about all internal matters of NH Hunger Solutions

Expectations of Individual Members

Each member is expected to:

1. Know NH Hunger Solutions mission, vision, policies, programs and needs
2. Faithfully read and understand the organization's financial statements
3. Serve as active ambassadors for the organization and fully engage in identifying and securing the financial resources and partnerships to advance NH Hunger Solutions mission
